

Super League Tiebreaker Rules

In the event two or more teams are tied after the regular season, the following tie breakers will be used.

Two teams. The higher placement will be decided as follows:

- One game played. Winner of the game. If this game is a tie, the team with the most wins in league play.
- Same number of wins, move on to the goal average tiebreaker.
- Goal average in overall league play. If this does not break the tie, move on to the final tiebreakers.

Two or more games played.

- One team wins both games.
- One win each, most wins in overall league play.
- More than two games played, the team that wins the most games.
- If the tie is not broken, move on to the goal average tiebreakers.
 - i) Goal average in the games between the teams.
 - ii) Goal average in overall league play.
 - iii) If this does not break the tie, move on to the final tiebreakers.

Three or more teams.

- Once a team is eliminated in the tiebreaker, the tiebreaker will start over with the remaining teams.
- If there are three or more teams tied in the standings, the following steps will be taken to break the tie.
 - If each team plays each other the same number of times, (e.g. The teams play each other once or twice.) the team with the most points in the games between them wins the tiebreaker.
 - If the games between the tied teams are not equal, (e.g. Team A plays Team B twice and Team C once while Team B plays Team C twice, etc.) the team with the most wins in league play wins the tiebreaker.
 - If this does not break the tie, the team with the higher goal average in league play wins the tiebreaker.
 - If this does not break the tie, move on to the final tiebreakers.
- Goal average.
- The maximum goal spread in a game will be five for tie breaker purposes. This is to reduce the incentive to run up the score in a game.

Goal average is determined by the following formula:

- $\text{Goals for} / (\text{Goals for} + \text{goals against}) = \text{Goal average}$
- The team with the highest goal average wins the tiebreaker.

Final tiebreakers.

- If the tie is still not broken, the team with the fewest PIMs in league play as per the OMAHA website.
- The last tiebreaker will be a coin toss supervised by the scheduler.
